Dear Sirs:-

9411 Replying to your favor of the 22nd inst., inquiring as to whether Baltimore City Stock is taxable in the counties, I beg to advise you that the county tax is generally imposed thereon, but it is usual for the City to pay all State taxes, for which the holders of such City stock may be liable. Provision to this effect is generally made in the several ordinances relating to issues of City stock.
