The penalty for such violation is fixed by Section 29 of the same Article, and is there declared to be a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Two hundred dollars (\$200), for each violation.

9430

The jurisdiction of Police Magistrates is fixed by Section 632 of the City Charter (Code of 1906, p.379), and is limited to all prosecutions or criminal proceedings for an act done, or omitted to be done, in the City of Baltimore, the doing of which act, or the omission to do which act, is, or may be, punishable by a pecuniary fine not exceeding One hundred dollars (\$100).

It, therefore, appears plain that the Police Magistrates have no jurisdiction over the class of offenses to which your letter refers.
