"Present name Prospect (Mt. Vernon) Avenue - proposed name Sisson Street".

Page 913.

"Present name Mt. Vernon Avenue - proposed future name Mt. Vernon Avenue (Northwest of Twenty-fourth St.). Sisson Street (South of Twenty-fourth St.).

It is apparent from the above extracts from the recommendations of Judge Brune, as approved by the City Council, that it is very uncertain what is the present correct name of Mt. Vernon, or Prospect, Avenue, - or, at least, that part thereof which is North of Twenty-fourth Street.

Certainly, it cannot be said that the name of any part of the street has been changed to Fifer Street.

Under Article 2 of Section 17 of the City Code of 1906, the Superintendent of Lamps and Lighting is authorized and directed to put the names of the streets on lamps at the corners of streets throughout the City, and since it cannot be said that Fifer Street is the name of any part of Mt. Vernon, or Prospect, Avenue, I, therefore, think that the Superintendent of Lamps and Lighting should not change the street signs to "Fifer Street".

As there is such uncertainty as to the correct name for this part of the street, I suggest that the Superintendent of Lamps and Lighting bring the matter to the attention of the Commissioners for Opening Streets, so that under Article 35, Section 102, the name of the street in question may be clearly and definitely fixed and established.
