Dear Sir:

I have your favor of the 14th, in which you ask the following question:

"If stock is registered in the name of two trustees only and they are trustees under a will, can I transfer the same upon an order of the Circuit Court with the certificate endorsed by one of the trustees, who endorses for the other trustee under a Power of procuracy? If so, what proof should I require to show that he has a legal right to sign P. P. for his co-trustee?"

If the Circuit Court has acquired full jurisdiction and by its order authorizes the certificate to be endorsed by one of the trustees on behalf of himself and his co-trustee, you would be fully protected.

The order of court should expressly authorize the endorsement which is tendered.
