Dear Sir:

9867 I am replying to your letter to me of January 16th, enclosing a letter of the same date, addressed to you by the Health Commissioner, with reference to repaving the alley North of Stockholm Street, between Wicomico and Scott Streets.

I find that by a letter addressed to Mr. B. T. Fendall, City Engineer, under date of November 10th, it was the opinion of this Department that said alley is private. This being true, and if the Commissioner of Health deems it necessary to repave the alley, in order to abate the nuisance - dangerous to the health of the inhabitants of the City - he should proceed to have the same repaved, in accordance with Ordinance No. 13, approved October 23, 1905, which appears as Sections 85-88 of Article 35⁶ in the City Code. In other words, it is necessary to give notice, plat the property, etc., before proceeding to pave.
