Dear Sir:

I return herewith your favor of the 27th ultimo, together with the papers which were sent to me therewith.

I find that Cecil Avenue, to which the aforesaid papers relate, is private. It appears to me that, in such circumstances, the Building Inspector is not concerned about the ownership of the street bed, or any part thereof, but should issue the building permit requested, if the improvements are to be constructed in conformity with the requirements of the Building Code, and should leave the question of legal right, which is in dispute between persons in interest, to be settled by the Courts.
