Orphans' Court.

Reference to the copy of the will of John Shotwell Townsend discloses the fact that Mrs. Townsend holds the securities as life-tenant with an unqualified power of sale.

The securities in question, however, were transferred to Mrs. Townsend under an order of the Orphans' Court. It is possible the Court has assumed jurisdiction of the fund under Section 10 of Article 93 of the Code.

Under these circumstances the City Register should not honor any transfer not authorized by order of that Court.
