I had referred it to one of my assistants but he had been so continually engaged that he was not able to take it up.

The School Board is under no liability to anyone who may be injured in the service. If there is any liability, under any circumstances, it is on the City and not on the School Board, and the liability of the City depends upon whether or not the party is engaged in a hazardous occupation.

I advise, therefore, that in cases of all claims made on the School Board for compensation for injuries, you refer the claim to me, at the same time making a full report as to the facts.
