Referring to your recent telephone conversation, in regard to Mr. Harry C. Thomas, I advise that we expect to get a general provision from the Legislature authorizing the City to provide for pensions in the Ordinance of Estimates from year to year, for aged employees and employees injured in the service- something similar to what now obtains in the Police and the Fire Departments. We hope, therefore, that no effort will be made to get a special Bill to cover the case of Mr. Thomas. We think that this subject should be covered by some general legislation and not by a special Act applying to each particular case.
