Dear Mr. Mayor:

I have before me your letter of recent date through your secretary Mr. James W. Clayton, asking that I furnish you with a list of officers and employees required to give bond.

Attached you will find copy of detailed statement concerning this situation and some general provisions of the Charter with reference to the matter.

Following out what I believe to be the sound opinion of previous City Solicitors, I would advise that wherever a bond is required by the Charter to be given, the official giving the same must pay the premium. On the other hand where there is no definite provision in the Charter with reference to the bond the City is required to pay this premium.
