GENERAL PROVISIONS WITH REFERENCE
TO BONDS OF CITY OFFICIALS.

"All municipal officials, unless otherwise pro-
vided for by laws or ordinances, shall give bond
to the City for the faithful discharge of their
duties to be approved by the Mayor and in such
penalties as may be prescribed by laws or ordi-
nances."

Charter Sec. 31, page 66.

"The several municipal officials, officers, em-
ployees and agents who are not entitled to com-
pensation for their services, or whose compen-
sation shall not exceed two hundred dollars (\$200)
per annum; unless otherwise provided by laws or
ordinances, shall not be required to give bond
for the faithful performance of their duties, un-
less the Mayor shall think it expedient to re-
quire the same."
