I have, your favor of September 30th, submitting the question of whether or not your Board has the power under the Zoning Ordinance to place a time restriction upon the exercise of the approval of an appeal or whether the Board's approval grants to the applicant an unlimited period within which he may exercise this right.

I do not find anywhere in the Ordinance any provision which authorizes your Board to impose a time restriction, and consequently, it is my opinion that your Board does not possess this power.
