advise you if you have the authority to prohibit the sale of lead tetraethyl in bulk.

Your letter does not state what quantity is being sold and whether or not there is a present emergency requiring that its sale be prohibited. If there is an emergency existing at present which would make the sale of this gas dangerous to the public safety, I think you have the power to prohibit its sale; but unless such an emergency does exist, it is my opinion that an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore would be necessary.
