Gentlemen,

I am going to ask the Board to reconsider the request of Frank Markiewicz, Agent for the Polish Falcons of America, Inc., for a refund of \$25.00 for a special license issued and later recalled by the Liquor Board.

I had Mr. Michael J. Hankin, of this office, make a further study of the matter and I have concluded that since the license was issued through an error of the Liquor Board and subsequently recalled by them without the applicant having an opportunity to use the same, it would be inequitable for the City to retain this money.

I, therefore, recommend that the Board of Estimates direct the refund of \$25.00 to Mr. Frank Markiewicz, Agent for the Polish Falcons of America, Inc., for license erroneously issued by the Liquor Board of Baltimore and not used by the applicant.

I enclose Mr. Hankin's opinion.
