Dear Mr. Bernhardt:

This is in response to your inquiry, dated December 20, 1950,  
relating to Section 7 of the Declaration of Policy covering per diem employees.

Section 7, in essence provides that where an employee receives  
a disability wherein he is entitled to the benefits of the Workmen's Compensation Act,  
he shall then be entitled to receive the difference between the amount received under  
the Act and his regular pay for a period of twelve full work days.

The two questions which you pose relate to the application of this  
Section upon an annual basis.

In view of the fact that Section 7 recites only "twelve (12) full  
work days" it would seem that its application would involve the first twelve (12)  
days only.

We trust that this satisfactorily answers your questions.
