Dear Mr. Walters:

In your letter of October 21, 1961, you requested an opinion of this office concerning the legal sufficiency of a proposed form of agreement having to do with the hiring of additional manpower and equipment from contractors in order to supplement the City's own manpower and equipment during periods of heavy snowfall, so that the City will have an adequate snow removal program when needed.

This agreement makes provision for the hiring of a number of heavy duty straight trucks, gradalls, motor graders, various size motors, and other equipment, together with working and supervisory personnel, all to be used in connection with the removal of snow from public property. It further provides for a period of "stand-by" time (minimum of four hours) of a sufficient number of vehicles and personnel in the event it is determined by
