Dear Mr. Wagner:

You have requested an opinion of this office as to whether a member of the Employees Retirement System may apply for accidental disability benefits on account of an injury he received when he was an employee of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore but was not yet enrolled as a member.

You cite the case of Daniel W. Meyers who was employed by the Department of Education as a heavy duty laborer on May 9, 1961; was allegedly injured during the course of his employment on June 13, 1961; joined the Employees Retirement System on October 20, 1961, which was approximately four (4) months after
