Re: Temporary Parking - Mechanical
Street Sweeping Pilot Program

Dear Mr. Benton:

You have requested our opinion in connection with
the pilot program to experiment with mechanical street sweeping.
In order to test mechanical sweeping, it is contemplated that
within four or five small areas of the City to be selected,
parking would be banned on one side of the street during certain
regular, pre-selected, posted times. The experimental program is
expected to last from thirty to sixty days. You wish to know
whether or not it is possible to control parking in this manner.
