Dear Mr. Wagner:

On October 16, 1962, you requested an opinion as to whether James and Michael Verderamo, the designated beneficiaries of Louis Natale, a deceased member of the Employees Retirement System, could receive ordinary death benefits on account of the death of the said member.

Mr. Natale, upon becoming a member, duly filed a designation naming his aunt as beneficiary, but on February 14, 1956, he filed a "change of beneficiary", naming the above mentioned James and Michael Verderamo, whom he described as "cousins," to be
