Dear Mr. Benton:

By recent letter you asked our opinion pertaining to whether or not the position of "College Plant Manager" at Baltimore Junior College would come within the classification of "professional employee" as that phrase is used in Article VII, Sec. 58(b), of the Baltimore City Charter (1964 Revision).

Said Section 59(b), in part, provides as follows:

" * * * Professional employees include teachers, personnel concerned with the supervision, administration, and direction of the educational program and related services, and other employees whose positions require a knowledge of and participation in the educational program. Any employee considered a professional employee under the provisions of Article 77, Section 159(c) of the Code of Public General Laws, and any amendment thereof, shall be deemed to be a professional employee for the purposes of this Charter. * * * All secretaries, clerks and employees, other than professional employees, shall be appointed and may be removed by the Board in accordance with the provisions of the Charter relating to the Classified Civil Service. * * * "
