Dear Colonel Colonna:

You have requested an opinion from this office as to whether or not the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore is obligated to pay to the State Roads Commission the sum of \$28,230.12 which sum represents that part of the cost of the construction of the spur road from the Baltimore-Washington Expressway to Friendship Airport for administrative and general expenses of the State Roads Commission in connection with the construction of said road.

On February 2nd, 1950, an agreement was entered into between the State Roads Commission of Maryland and the City of Baltimore by which the Commission agreed to construct approximately 1.03 miles of road from the Baltimore-Washington Expressway to the Administration Building of the airport. Among other
