Item I give and bequeath to Mary Kemble the daughter of my cousin Robert Suite Kemble the sum of one hundred dollars to be paid out of my personal estate also three family pictures which are now in my possession.

Item I give and bequeath to my God daughter Eleanor Maria Blake wife of Charles P Blake the sum of one hundred dollars to be paid out of my personal estate also my wearing apparell my best set of Tea China also a set of Britannia Metal & one gold ring and should it not be necessary to sell the Carriage to paying debts I also give and bequeath the to the said Eleanor Maria Blake.

Item I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Laurens my God daughter and the daughter of Mr Philip Laurens the sum of one hundred dollars to be paid out of my personal estate also my Gold watch one gold ring and all the pictures in the parlour

Item I give and bequeath to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Peter Verlemaans one silver fluted soup ladle and a silver snuff box

Item I give and bequeath to Doct<sup>r</sup> Edward Earle twenty five dollars to be paid out of my personal estate.

Item In case my personal property other than Negroes shall not be sufficient to pay debts and legacies I do hereby direct my executor hereafter mentioned to sell so many of my male Negroes until they attain the age of thirty two years at which time it is my will and desire that they be free those under sixteen years of age I wish to be free at the age of twenty five and none to be sold out of the state.
