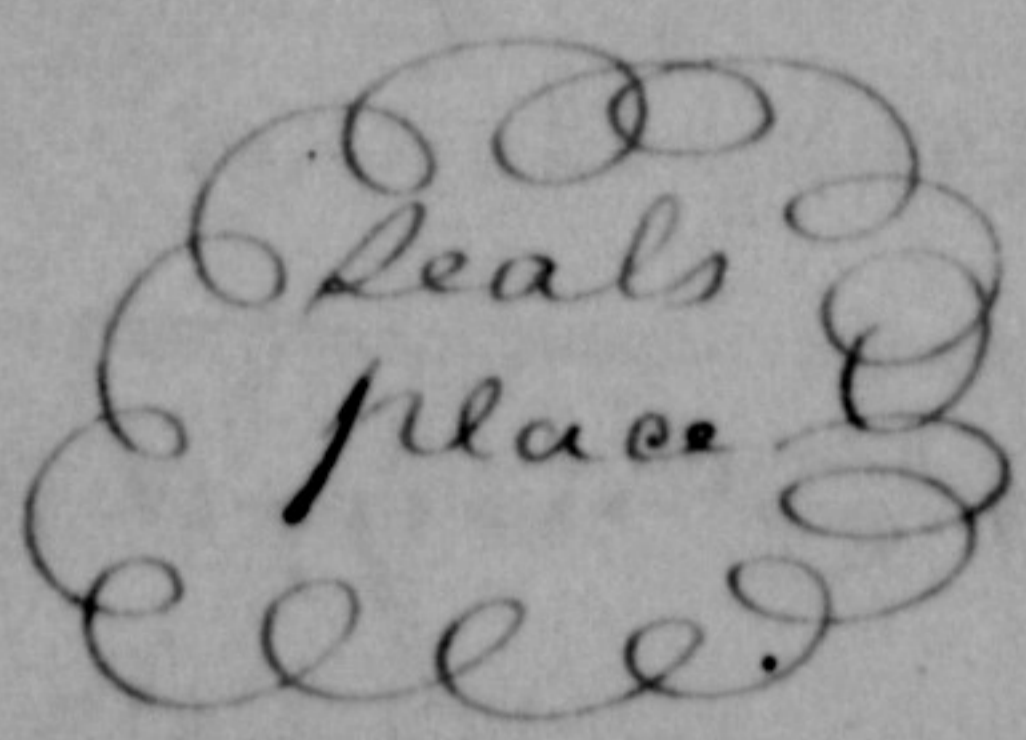

To all persons to whom these presents shall come, Greeting: Know ye, that the last will and testament of Elizabeth Richmond late of Queen Anns County deceased hath in due form of law been exhibited proved and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Queen Anns County a copy of which is to these presents annexed and administration of all the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased is hereby granted and committed unto Thomas J Wilson Adm^r with the Will annexed. Witness Thomas Wright Esq^r Chief Justice of the Orphan's Court of Queen Anns County this 19th day of May Anno Domini 1832.
