And it is also considered by the Court here that the said Negro Anna Barnet recover against the said Thomas S Wilson the sum of twelve dollars & twenty cents by the Court here unto the said Negro Anna Barnet adjudged on her Assent for her costs and charges by her about the prosecution of her petition aforesaid laid out and expended and that she have there of her execution &c. And thereupon the aforesaid Thomas S Wilson by his Attorney aforesaid pray an appeal from the Judgment aforesaid so as aforesaid rendered to the High Court of Appeals to be held at the City of Annapolis on the first Monday of December next and the same is granted him. It is thereupon ordered by the Court here that the record and proceedings in the plea aforesaid with all things thereunto relating be transmitted to the said High Court of Appeals and the same are transmitted accordingly.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said Thomas S Wilson enter into recognizance with sufficient security to the State of Maryland in the sum of one thousand dollars jointly and severally for the appearance and security of the said Negro Anna Barnet according to the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided.

And thereupon the said Thomas S Wilson present here in Court in his proper person acknowledges himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto the State of Maryland in the sum of one thousand dollars. And John Scott Esquire also present here in Court in his proper person who by the Court here is deemed good and sufficient in like manner acknowledges himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto the
