and Sold, and by these Presents do grant, Bargain and Sell unto the Said
James Deale his Executors Administrators and
Assigns, the following Property to wit One ~~Year~~^{Man} Named
Charles aged about 32 years ^{Named Charles}, One Negro
Woman Named Hagar aged about 50 years, One Negro Woman Named
Julia aged about Twenty Six years, One Negro Woman Named
Lusti aged about 30 years, One Negro Girl Named Sarah aged about
14 years, One Negro Girl Named Fanny aged about 17 years
Six Leather Beds, Wedges and Furniture, Four Tables and Twelve Chairs
One Dash, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Dozen, One Ox Cart, Nine Head of Cattle the last two cut off
Five Horses, Seventeen head of Sheep Seventeen Hogs, Three Iron Pots
and Hooks, One Dutch Oven, One Tea Kettle.

All which Property is now in my Possession. To have and to hold the same
described Property above bargained and sold to the Said James Deale
his Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever. To
him and their only proper use and benefit: And the Said John Deale
for himself his Executors, and Administrators, Shall
and will warrant and forever defend by these Presents to the Said James
Deale his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, the Said
described Property, against him and his Executors and Administra-
tors, and against all and every other Person or Persons whomsoever, claiming
the same in any Part thereof. In testimony whereof I do have
hereunto Set my hand and affixed my Seal this Ninth
day of March in 1816.
