 That John Gwinn of Frederick County
 be appointed trustee for the sale
 of Negroes Jan, Henry and her Children Willfred, Anne
 and Gay, and her Children born since the 15th day of
 November 1790, which said Negroes were mortgaged by
 Samuel Cleland to Robert Ferguson on that day; and
 that the course and manner of his proceedings be as
 follows. That the said John Gwinn give four weeks public
 notice of the time and place of sale of said Negroes, that
 they be sold for Cash, and that he return to the Chancery
 Office under hand and Seal his proceedings in virtue
 of this order for Confirmation by the Court - and that the
 money arising from the Sales, or the receipt of Robert
 Ferguson,
