

and that he may be compelled to produce the same to your Honour
if in his possession and also whether the bequests mentioned and
conveyed to him in his will are not the same identical bequests
as of one and conveyed by his said Father in his lifetime to the
said Jeremiah Berry and why, and for what purpose or object did
the said Jeremiah Berry make to him the aforesaid bill of sale
marked Exhibit A, whether he ever paid to the said Jeremiah
Berry the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars the consid-
eration money mentioned in the said bill of sale, or any part thereof
or what part, where and with whom did the said Francis Ashon
live at the time of the conveyance made by him to the said
Jeremiah Berry, and at the time of the bill of sale marked
Exhibit A, from the said Jeremiah Berry to him the said
Joshua Ashon, where and with whom did the said Francis
Ashon live at the time of his death, and at what time did he
depart this life, whether upon his death be the said Joshua
Ashon did not possess himself of all the bequests and other property
of the said Francis Ashon and whether he does not now hold
the same to the exclusion of the other children of his said
deceased Father, whether there has been an administration on the
personal estate of the said Francis Ashon such why letters
of administration have not been applied for, and that the said
Joshua Ashon may also fully and particularly set forth and
describe all and every kind and description of property which
he hath possession of and now holds either before or at the
death of his said Father and which he claims either by the bill
of sale marked Exhibit A or in any other manner, and in what
manner, and by what authority he holds the same, and that he
may be compelled to account with your Compliments for the work
and labour of the said bequests and other property and the
profits which may have accrued from the time he obtained
possession thereof, until the present, and that your Honour
will by your decree vacate and annul all and every, absolutely
void to all intents and purposes the several conveyances
as made and described as aforesaid, and that your Honour
will grant to your Compliments such other and further relief
