In consideration whereof, and forasmuch as your orator is without remedy in the premises, except by the aid of this court, and to the end that all the defendants hereinafter named, may on oath answer this Bill, and that your orator may be allowed to account in this court, with all ~~the~~ parties entitled to this property, or claiming the same, and that your Honor may by decree decide which of the parties are entitled to the money and property in your orator's hands, and that your orator be decreed to pay or deliver the same accordingly, and that your orator may be allowed to pay the balance admitted by him to be due according to the said account into court to the credit of this suit to wit: Five Hundred and fifty three ³⁸/₁₀₀ dollars, ^{as per exhibit S. G. C. no 7.} and that your orator may settle and close up his said trust fully under the authority of this court - and that your orator may have such other and further relief as his case and equity require.

May it please your Honor to grant ~~me~~ to your orator the state of Maryland writ of subpoena to the said Shelby Clark, Marcus S. Chaney and Rachel his wife of Prince George's County; Isaiah Chaney and Eliza Ann Chaney of Baltimore City, and to Violetta Chaney, Victoria Elizabeth Chaney, Levi Mitchell Chaney, ^{Rosina Mitchell Chaney} and Solomon G. Chaney, ^{Junior and Henrietta G. Chaney} of Howard County, commanding them all to be and appear in this court to answer the several
