The Petition of John Wilmott Executor of John
Wilmott, deceased, Humbly sheweth

That a negroman named Jim was appraised in
the Estate of John Wilmott aforesaid to the sum of Sixty five
pounds current money.

That the said Slave was taken from
your ~~Plaintiff~~ Petitioner by a replevin and the same was
recovered as will more fully appear by the annexed short copy
of the Judgement and that he hath been at considerable
expence in defending the suit for which he was compelled to
pay, as by the Sheriffs receipt amounting to the sum of forty
five pounds fifteen shillings and 5^o Current money

That one black mare named Derrick and appraised
by 2^o Appraisers to the sum of Fifteen pounds Current money
died by accident within the first year and before he
could make sale thereof. He therefore prays an allowance
for the said Negro Jim and all expences and for the said
Mare agreeable to the Principles of Equity

And, he will pray

Negro Jim £65.0.0
Damages — 45.15.5
Black Mare 15.0.0
