Slave runs away, finds work with Lehman posing as a free person--"Negro boy came to deponents House and represented himself to be a Free boy, and lived with a certain Mr. Jamison at Powhattan Factory. . ."

Master "long ago notified said Henry of the existence and effect of the Acts of Assembly 1833 ch. 224 and 1845 ch. 105, and has warned him that the Court would extend his term of service, & order him to be sold out of the state" but the twenty year old slave who would be freed at age thirty five continued to run away; master asked that the slave term be extended and the slave sold out of state

**BALTIMORE COUNTY REGISTER OF WILLS (Petitions and Orders)** Carville S. Stansbury vs. Negro Nathaniel: petition 14 July 1858; answer [July 1858]; order of the court 20 July 1858; order of the court 10 August 1858; order of the court 31 August 1858  
Stansbury was the owner and master of sixteen-year-old Nathaniel for a term of nineteen years but the slave ran away twice and subjected him to "a large expense"; authorized to sell "service of said negro boy" in or out of the state; last order of the court added two years to the term of service to begin "from and after the period at which the said boy would be free by the terms of the last will and testament of Tobias E. Stansbury, his late owner"
