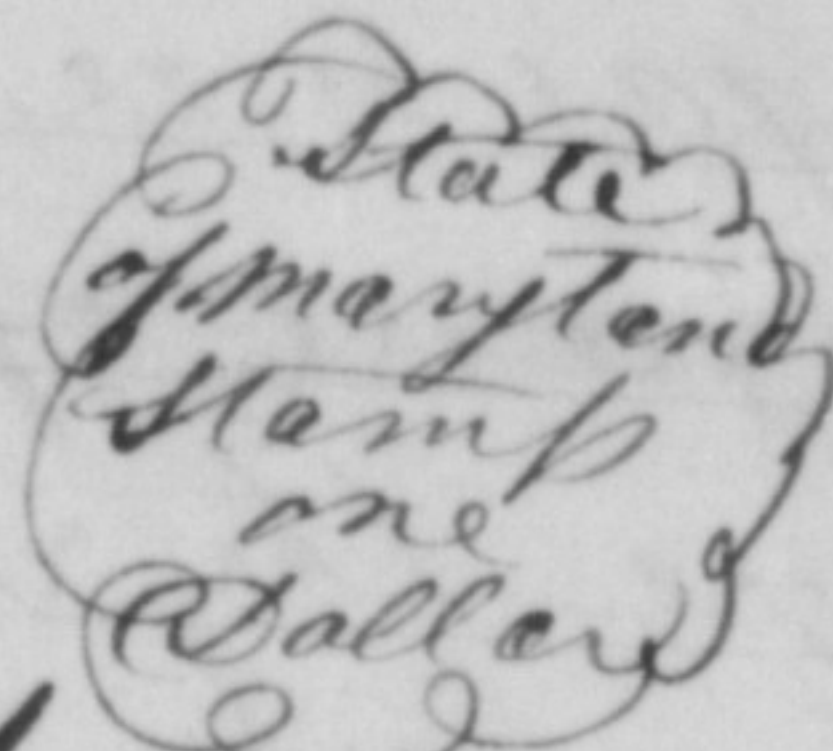


Ellen Bosley
Bill of Sale to
Richard Hutchins of



This deed made this
March 24th day of March
in the year Eighteen

hundred and forty seven, between
Ellen Bosley of Baltimore County in the State of Maryland
of the one part, and Richard Hutchins of the said County
of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of three hundred dollars lawful money, to
the party hereto of the first part paid by the party of
the second part hereto at or before the sealing and
delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged, the said Ellen Bosley hath bargained, and sold
and doth hereby bargain and sell, assign and transfer
unto the said Richard Hutchins of the said County
Matilda aged about fifteen years, Do Have and Do Hold
the negro girl Matilda unto the said Richard
Hutchins of the said County his executors administrators and
assigns to his and their use hereafter until she
shall attain the age of forty four years, at which
period the said Matilda will be entitled to freedom
and she is by these presents declared to be thenceforth
liberated manumitted and discharged from
slavery and bondage; And the said Ellen Bosley
doth hereby covenant with the said Richard
Hutchins of the said County his representatives, that the said negro
is, at the time of the execution hereof, in a sound and
healthy condition in every respect. In Witness

their names and affixed their seals on the day
and year first above written
