when Patterson abused his wife very much
because she would not go to an unfinished
log house upon her land to live with him. He
told her that if she would not go he would
scandalize her in every way in which he could.
After she refused to go he told her that he only
wanted her to go that her mother might support
her at the house & that he might come in at any
time to get something to eat & at the same time
& place Complainant charged Patterson with hav-
ing sold said woman & child which he did
not deny & even promised to give her a couple
of colts which he said he had in part payment
for said negro. Which he has never done.
He abused her by cursing bitterly & using of-
fensive language towards her such as no her-
band ought to use towards his wife & said he
never would support her.

7th - He has not lived with her since the Spring
of Eighteen hundred & sixty one or given her any
aid and support.

8th - She has made her home at the house of the
witness & been supported by her since the Spring
of - sixty one without any aid or support from
him.
