Daniel Egleton from the State of Maryland, but shall suffer and  
permit them to appear ~~at~~ <sup>the</sup> said County Court at the  
place and on the day aforesaid to prosecute their said  
petition; and shall at all times suffer the said Amey  
Egleton and Daniel Egleton to have a reasonable time to  
advise with <sup>their</sup> Counsel on their said petition, and shall also in  
the mean time clothe, feed and use the said Amey Egleton  
and Daniel Egleton well. Whereof he shall  
not fail, at his peril and fail you not at your peril  
and have you then and there this Writ.
