shall not transport the said Charles and Francis from the
State of Maryland but shall suffer and permit ~~them~~
to appear at ~~the~~ said county court at the place and on the
day aforesaid to prosecute their said Petition; and shall at
all times suffer the said Charles and Francis to have a
reasonable time to advise with their counsel on their said
Petition; and shall also in the mean time clothe feed, and
use the said Charles and Francis - well - Nevertheless he shall
not fail at his peril and fail you not at your peril and
have you then and then this writ. Witness the Honourable John
