

Prince Georges County September 4th 1811. —

Anthony Livers, aged seventy six years, deponent & Sworn, that his father Arnold Livers, late of Prince Georges County deceased, was possessed of a number of ~~negro slaves~~ and that the elder, and parents of most of them, was a certain negro man named Ophur, and a negro woman named Maria, which negro man & woman, the deponent always understood & believed, were brought from Africa and purchased by his said father as slaves, and that from their language, colour, ^{which was as black as other negroes} and woolly hair, this deponent never doubted or knew to be doubted that the negroes aforesaid were Africans. This deponent says his said father has been dead about ^{17 1/2} fifty five or six years, that the said negro Maria died before his father, as well as he can collect. The names of her children, were Sam, Luca, Muley, Mole, Felix, & Maria. This deponent further says that the above named Maria, was the only ~~black~~ ^{black} person of that name, of which ^{there was a yellow man named Malaguarack in his father's family.} his father was possessed. This deponent was about the age of Felix, before now named.
