on this 2nd day of April 1835 being the return day to the
within warrant, the same was submitted to me for trial,
and it being in evidence before me from the confessions
and acknowledgements of the defendant, ^{a free woman of color} that she lived in
the city of Washington for four months at least with a certain
Mr William Berry during which time she received the sum of
four dollars per month for hire some time in the year 1834
and that she has been living in this county ever since the
25th day of December last. I do therefore adjudge that
the said Milly Bowser has been in and remained in this
state for the space of twelve weeks having emigrated
to the same from the District of Columbia, and I do therefore
impose ~~the~~ fine of fifty dollars per week on the said
Milly Bowser being the sum of six hundred dollars,
one half thereof for the use of Nathaniel Suit the infer
Prince Georges County according to the provisions of the
act of assembly in such case made & provided. Given under
the hand & seal of me the subscriber one of the State of Maryland
Justice of the peace in and for Prince Georges County this 2nd
day of April 1834
