## Exotic Nassau A coolbargain

Tassau, Bahamas - Although there is virtually no seasonal difference in the exotic Bahama Islands, visitors coming here from May 1st through December. 14 can enjoy doing everything the winter jet-setters do at accommodations savings of up to 40 percent.

And for the spring-summer-fall months of 1970 these 700 lovely islands and islets have never promised greater opportunities to suit the recreational tastes of all vaca-

The economy months mean that the whole family can enjoy the bluest of blue skies; swim in clear seas that look from the air like a child's finger painting, and acquire the deepest tan from a sun that seldom hides behind a cloud.

This "hot bargain" is always cooled by constant trade vinds that gently stir the palm fronds so that even when the temperature rises above the low eighties, as it seldom does, visitors feel little discomfort.

More than a dozen resort Out Islands are only minutes away from Nassau by scheduled daily air services, or they can be reached by private, chartered or rented aircraft, yachts or powerboats.
