Among mechanics and repairers, the most rapid increases will be for workers who repair computers, office machines, air conditioners and industrial machinery.

In contrast, a continuation of the long - run employment decline in the railroad industry will lead to the decline of some craft occupations concentrated in that industry, such as railroad and car shop

Because of advances in printing technology, very little growth is anticipated in printing crafts.

Nonfarm Laborers (11 percent projected growth rate, 1976 - 1985):

Employment in this group is expected to grow only slowly as machinery increasingly replaces manual labor in construction and manufacturing, the two largest employers of these workers.

Farmworkers (32 percent projected decline, 1976

Employment of these workers has declined for decades as farm productivity has increased as a result of the trend toward fewer but larger farms, the use of more and better machinery and the development of new feeds, fertilizers and pesticides.
