





products on the market made especially for those conditions.

After washing, dry skin will benefit from a mild astringent, particularly one which helps to restore the protective acid mantle which can be washed away by

Read the label to be sure that the product has a ph level that is close to that of the skin (approximately 4.5 to 5.5). Apply with a cotton ball.

Normal to oily skin can stand a stronger astringent such as witch hazel or Bonne Bell's 1006. The latter product is excellent for removing white heads, black heads and drying up those feverish little pimples.

Any type of skin needs a periodic scurbbing with cleansing grains to remove surface dirt and dead cells. Always follow this with the mildest available astringent (harsh ones may burn a little), and then moisturize if your skin is dry.

Cleaning of the body skin should be done with as much care as cleaning the face. Deodorant soaps are good deodorizers, but they are drying to the skin.

Try bathing with a milder soap; and use a loofah instead of a wash cloth to remove surface dirt

and smooth away dead cells.

They are widely available in various forms at drug and supermarkets.

No matter what your skin type, you need moisture, which is not the same as oil. Water retention in body tissues is an internal problem caused by improper diet, especially too much salt. It results in bloating and cellulite.

Water retention in the first three layers of the skin is an external benefit. It helps the skin retain its soft, supple quality, and helps prevent wrinkles.

According to Dr. Irving D. Wolfe, assistant professor of dermatology at the University of Maryland, "Oil is the barrier which holds moisture in the skin. Most skin has this protective layer throughout adolescence and young adulthood.

As we get older, the glands produce less oil and washing with harsh deodorant soaps can remove even much of what is produced. In winter, you can actually become a sort of humidifier for the dry aif around you as water in the skin evaporates.

Applying moisturizers after bathing replaces some lost oil, allowing the skin to retain more of its own natural moisture."
