Household Tips

West Lafayette, Ind. — It's possible to save thousands of dollars on the purchase of a home if you're lucky enough to find a condemned house that can be moved to a new location.

Houses sometimes are condemned because of a new highway
or other construction. Donn E.
Hancher, associate professor of
construction engineering and
management at Purdue
University, says such a house may
be purchased cheaply—perhaps
for a few hundred dollars. When
moved to a new site, the house
serves just as well as if it had been
erected there.

However, be sure to line up a house mover before you agree to buy a condemned house, Hancher emphasizes. A buyer stuck with a condemned house that can't be moved would not only lose his investment but might also be sued for the cost of demolishing the structure.

BUYING PET FOOD


Buying large supplies of pet food at a quantity discount might not be a savings after all.

Dr. Walter Weirich, head of Purdue University's Small Animal Clinic, notes that any time you buy pet food in large quantities it should be used as soon as possible once the package is opened. If not

used within about six weeks, he says, the food will begin losing its nutritional value.

But even though the food package is not opened, he adds, both flavor and nutritive qualities start to wane after a time. Unopened, he says, a sack of dry pet food will start to lose these qualities in about six months. Even canned food, observes Weirich, begins to lose nutrients and flavor if kept two years or so. For cats, he says, the three

pounds or so a self-feeder will hold is about all that can be used at a time without fear of the food's being affected by exposure.
