4 cup Florida orange juice
One third cup finely chopped blanched almonds

1 egg white beaten with 1 teaspoon water

1 cup confectioners' sugar 2 tablespoons butter or margarine, at room temperature

I to 2 teaspoons milk
Few drops green food color
Red cinnamon candies

In a large bowl mix flour, 34 cup sugar, 2 teaspoons orange peel and salt. Using a pastry blender put in butter and orange juice until mixture holds together. Knead a few times and press into a ball. Shape dough into 34 - inch balls; lightly roll each on a floured board into a 6 - inch - long strip. Using two strips, twist together to make a rope.

Pinch ends of rope together to make a wreath; place on lightly greased baking sheet. In a shallow dish, mix almonds with remaining ¼ cup sugar and I teaspoon orange peel. Brush the top of each wreath with egg white mixture and sprinkle with sugar - almond mixture.

Bake in a 400 degree F. oven 8 to 10 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove to wire racks; cool completely. To decorate: in a small bowl mix confectioners' sugar, butter, 1 teaspoon milk and a few drops green food color.

Add more milk if necessary to make frosting thick, but spreadable. Fill a pastry bag fitted with a small leaf tip (preferably No. 67). Decorate each wreath with 3 or 4 leaves and redcinnamon - candy berries. Yield: 5 dozen cookies.
