No musician has had a more profound effect on the orchestra approach to small groups over the last 25 years than Ahmad Jamal. His sense of song structure and internal dynamics had been equalled only infrequently, and the graceful precision with which he asserts his personality has hardly been equalled at all.


Jamal is an adventuresome pianist, full of surprises and everfluid pianist, with fingers literally skimming the keys of the in-
