

# Parent groups agree on record labeling

WASHINGTON—Two parents' organizations, one comprised of well-connected Washington music with explicit lyrics.

Association and the Parents Music Resource Center praised the agreement as a victory for consumers even though they appeared to gain few concessions from the Record Industry Association of America.

"We feel this is a win situation for everyone who is involved," Ann Kahn, president of the 5.6-million member PTA, told a news conference at the National

Under the agreement, record companies that release music with lyrics that are considered to include "explicit sex, explicit violence or explicit substance abuse" are urged to take one of two actions. They can label the music "Explicit Lyrics — Parental Advisory" or they can provide the lyrics on the album cover.

Twenty-two of the record association's 44 members, representing about 80 percent of records released in the United States, have agreed to follow the guidelines. The procedures are expected to take effect in 60 to 90

"The companies are urged to implement the steps ... as soon as possible," said association President Stanley Gortikov, who explained the companies will decide
