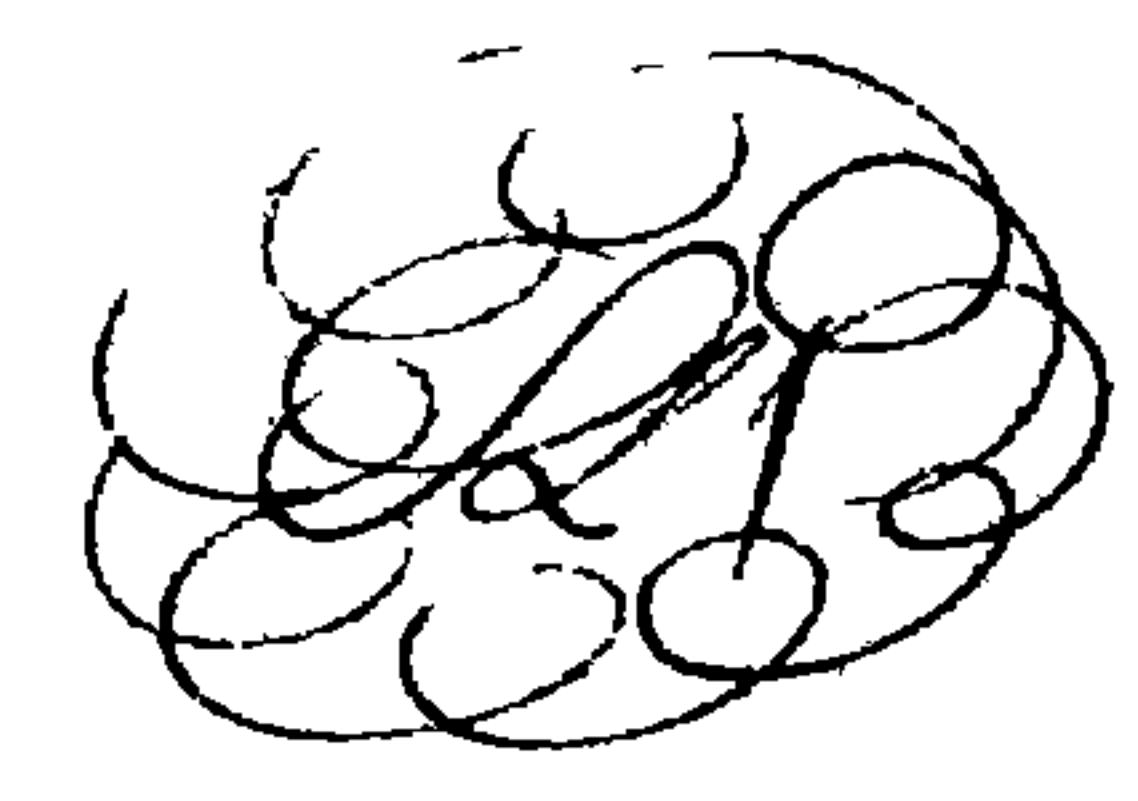

At the request of Geo. L. Routzong the following deed was Recorded 2<sup>d</sup> Apr '38

This Indenture made this 10<sup>th</sup> March 1838. Between John Routzong, and Sarah his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part; and George L. Routzong of the County and State aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth, that the said John Routzong and Sarah his wife, for & in Consideration of the sum of \$4700 current money of the United States, to them in hand paid, by the said George L. Routzong, before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said John Routzong, and Sarah his wife do hereby acknowledge. Have bargained & sold, aliened, enfeoffed & confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell, alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said George L. Routzong, his heirs & assigns, all their unworried, interest, of in and to the following Tracts, or parcels of Land and premises to wit all the plantations which was conveyed by a certain Benjamin Routzong to the said John Routzong, and George L. by deed, bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> March 1838. duly executed & acknowledged, according to law containing 154 1/2 acres, of land more or less, & also their own divided Interest of that part of a Tract of land, called Puzglesome Correction, as also conveyed by the aforesaid Benjamin Routzong, to the said John Routzong, George L. Routzong by deed bearing the same, with the above referred to containing 59 1/4 acres of land more or less. Together with all & singular the rights, appurtenances to the same belonging -
