To the Honorable the Judges of Frederick County Court as a Court of Equity the Bill of Complaint of Henry Rouger - John Rouger & William. C. Lawsons executors of the Last will of Daniel Rouger, late of Frederick County dec<sup>d</sup> Respectfully sheweth - that a certain Daniel Shafer by his sealed note, dated on the sixteenth day of February in the year eighteen hundred and forty two, payable twenty four months after date, became indebted, and promised to pay to said Daniel Rouger the sum of one hundred & twenty four Dollars fifty two Cents, with Interest from the date, as will fully appear by reference to said sealed note, herewith exhibited, marked N<sup>o</sup> 1, which exhibit together with all other exhibits, herein after produced, your complainants pray may be taken as a part of this their bill of Complaint, your complainants further state that the said Daniel Shafer, to secure the payment of the said note & the interest thereon, on the sixteenth day of February in the year 1842 by deed of Mortgage, conveyed to the said Daniel Rouger, his heirs & assigns, all that messuage or Tenement, situate on water Street in Frederick Town, and adjoining the lots of Joseph Melhise James Stokes Henry Rouger and a public alley containing about three acres of Land the same then being in the possession of said Daniel Shafer, and also all the right Title Interest and Estate, of the said Daniel Shafer of in and to a certain Lot of Land, situate near Mechanics Town, containing about three acres, of Land more or less adjoining the Lands of Joseph Stubbs, Daniel Wrenman, Hantkays heirs & Elizabeth Gernant which said deed of Mortgage was subject to the condition, that the said Daniel Shafer, his heirs & assigns, and administrators should well and truly pay unto the said Daniel Rouger, his executors administrators or assigns the aforesaid debt, or sum of one hundred & twenty four Dollars & fifty two Cents, with Interest, on the day & time before mentioned, and appointing for the payment thereof, according -

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
