I have endeavoured to make a just division of my estate among my children, after much earnest reflection upon the situation, and circumstances of each of them. My affection, and Interest in their welfare induced me to distribute among them the largest part of my property, so that they might have the present enjoyment of it. I hope they will all approve, and acquiesce in what I have done.

I hereby republish, & confirm my will, and Codicils so far as they are consistent herewith, and I direct that all future entries made by me or by my order, in my said account Book, &c. shall be taken into view in settling my estate, In Witness whereof I the said Jacob Myer have hereunto set my hand & seal, as the fourth Codicil to my will, on this 27 day of December, eighteen hundred & forty five
