berson his wife of the State of Ohio. Philip N. Trovill of Baltimore
County State of Maryland, and Felix G Trovill of Frederick County
State of Maryland Respectfully sheweth, That a certain Peter
Trovill, late of Frederick County State of Maryland in the year
eighteen hundred and thirty six, died intestate, leaving a
widow named Catherine Trovill and seven children wit
Mary A Rebecca Trovill, who married Joseph Zacharias
Amanda E Trovill, who married John G. Robertson Philip N
Trovill, and Felix G. Trovill, your complainants, all of whom
are of full age, and the following names, infant children
under the age of twenty one years, who reside in Frederick
County, State of Maryland, to wit: Am C Trovill, Emily
G. Trovill, and Andrew J. Trovill, your complainants further
state, that the said Peter Trovill, at the time of his death
died seized and possessed of a farm, situate in Frederick
County, containing about one thousand acres of land -
more or less a tract of mountain land, containing 15
acres of land more or less, which said land is carefully des-
cribed in the copies of deeds herewith exhibited marked
exhibits N^o 1, 2, 3, 4, which exhibits together with all
others herein after produced your complainants pray may
be taken as a part of this their bill of Complaint
your complainants state: That the lands & Tenements
described in the foregoing exhibits, descended to your com-
plainants, and the said infant children of Peter Trovill
decd, as Tenants in Common, and that it will be for the
Interest & advantage of all parties interested therein both
Infants, and adults heirs, that the said lands should be sold,
under a decree of your Honorable Court, and the proceeds
thereof distributed among the said parties, complainants
and defendants, In Tenon Consideration whereof, and for
as much as your complainants are remediless in the
premises by the strict rules of Common Law and only re-
lievable in a Court of Equity, where matters of such nature and
properly Cognizable, and to the end that the Real Estate wher-
of Peter Trovill decd seized and possessed may be sold under
a decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds thereof
distributed among the parties Concerned, and to the end that
your complainants, may have all such other, and further relief
in the premises as may be consistent with Equity, and the
nature of Their case. May it please your Honors, to grant
to your complainants the writ of Subpoena, in the usual form
used to the Sheriff of Frederick County, Commanding
