Kiegly Inham Sullivan, Martha Devan, Rebecca Kiegly & Jacob Kiegly. That both the executors appointed by the Testator are dead.

And the Bill prays for a Decree, for the sale of said Real Estate for Distribution of proceeds among the parties entitled. It is thereupon this 12th day of September 1850. as judged & ordered that the Complainants, by causing a Copy of this Order to be inserted in some newspaper published in District Town once a week, for one month, before the Twentieth day of October 1850 and notice to the said absent defendants, and to the heirs of Westal Kiegly, and the heirs of Mary Ann Deaver of the object and substance of this Bill; & warn them to be, and appear, in this Court, in person or by solicitor, on or before the 25th of January 1851. to answer the premises, and show cause if any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
