Final Order by the Court, this 25. day of February, 1852. that Rat the foregoing report of sales as modified by the Order passed in this case, on the fifth of February, 1852 on the Petition of Michael Keefer, Thomas Crumpton, and Henry J. Dea. reo. be, and the same is hereby finally ratified & confirmed, no cause to the contrary having been shown, though notice appears to have been given as prescribed by the preceding Order. The Trustee is allowed for his Commission the sum of four hundred and fifty two dollars, & seventy cents, and for his expenses, such sum as he shall produce Vouchers for, to the auditor. The case is hereby referred to the auditor, to state an account between the Trustee & the creditors of Richard Johnson, after giving to the latter, three weeks previous notice to file their claims duly authenticated, with the Clerk of this Court. Eight. McK. Abome Farm. Being part of a Tract of Land called Peira Land patented to said Richard Johnson by the State of Maryland on 7 March 1838. Beginning for said part at the end of 43 1/2 ps. on the first line of said Land, it also being the middle of what is called "The Ridge Road" & running thence with said Land, called Peira Land, 6 courses, & distances by S 65 1/2° allowing such variation along the lines as is necessary to correspond with the original survey of said Land 69 1/2 ps to a stone No. 1, standing at the south West corner of Joseph Waltman's land, and with said Waltman's land 5 courses, viz S 25° N 121 ps. to a stone No. 2. S 33° E 44 ps. to a stone No. 3. S 25° N 105 1/4 ps to a stone No. 4 S 30° E 40 ps to a stone No. 5 S 11 1/2° E 20 1/10 ps on the 6th line of said Land, called Peira Land, then leaving the out-lines of said Land, and running across a part of the same viz N 72° N 123 1/2 ps to a stone planted N 60 3/4° N 82 1/10 ps. to the Post & Rail fence separating the Land hereby conveyed, and that part of said Tract, called Peira Land, still unswold, thence following said fence N 11 1/4° E 60 50/100 ps. to the sd of Land lately owned by George Rhodes and also to the end of the 53rd line of said Tract of Land called Peira Land, and following the same to the end of the 56 line of the same viz. S 63 1/4° E 1 allowing for variation 23 1/2 ps. to a stone No. 54 N 26 1/2° E 30 1/10 ps to a stone No. 55. ps planted at the Root of a marked Locust Tree, then N. 64° N 21 1/2 ps. to a stone No. 56 then again leaving the out-lines of said Land by the following courses, & distances. viz. N 34 1/4° E 20 ps. into the middle of the above mentioned Ridge Road, and in and along the middle of the same, two courses, and distances. viz. N 44 1/4° E 140 ps. N 45 1/2° E. 59 35/100 ps. to the sd line of Beginning, containing 256 acrs & 30 squares of Land.
