To The Honorable the Judges of Frederick  
County Court, sitting as a Court of Equity The Bill of Com-  
plaint of Mary E. Beck an Infant under the age of twenty  
one years, by Aaron Beck her next friend respectfully shews  
That Jacob Walker as next friend of your Complainant Mary  
E. Beck filed a Bill in your Honorable Court, against your  
Complainant, and Isaac Walker, and Jacob Walker Executors  
of John Walker, alleging that the Interest of your com-  
plainant required, that the Equitable Interest of your com-  
plainant, and the legal title held by the said Isaac & Jacob Wal-  
ker as executors, in the land, and premises, mentioned in the said  
proceedings should be sold, that the proceeds, should be applied  
to pay the sum of the balance of the purchase money due  
said executors by his father, and testator, and the residue  
be appropriated to your Complainant, and that a commis-  
sion should be issued to three freeholders, to view & value  
the said lands, and premises, your Complainant further  
states that a commission was issued to three freeholders  
two of whom upon examination, returned to the Court, That  
the value of the said property, including the lien due the said  
Isaac & Jacob, as executors was six hundred dollars That  
the said Executors answering the said Bill, admitted the facts,  
& consented to a sale, and that your Honorable Court by a de-  
cree passed on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February eighteen hundred &  
forty six directed the said property to be sold, and appointed  
Jacob Walker Trustee to make said sale, That said Trustee  
after filing his bond, duly approved, and did on the seventeenth  
day of March, eighteen hundred, and forty six make a pretended  
sale of the said property to one Aaron Beck, at and for the sum  
of six hundred dollars which sale was reported to & finally  
ratified by your Honorable Court.

Your complainant further states that an audit was sub-  
sequently made out distributing said proceeds, of sale, and  
that after deducting therefrom the sum of Eighty four dollars  
& fourteen cents, the Costs & Commission's in said case, and one  
hundred & three dollars & fifty nine cents, the lien of unpaid  
purchase money, due the said Isaac & Jacob Walker as executors  
The balance of said funds amounting to four hundred & six dollars  
and twenty seven cents, was distributed to your Complainant -

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
